PROCEEDINGS: ORDER FROM CHAMBERS

Plaintiffs Cruise Lines International Association Alaska and Cruise Lines International Association and defendants the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska, and Rorie Watt, in his official capacity as City Manager, by and through their respective counsel, filed a joint motion¹ requesting an extension of the stay of pretrial deadlines while the parties continue settlement efforts.
