ORDER

Stipulation Regarding Responses
to Rule of Law Motion and Summary Judgment Motion¹

Plaintiffs and defendants have filed an agreed stipulation requesting that any response by plaintiffs to the *Motion to Determine the Law of the Case on the Tonnage Clause and Rivers and Harbors Act and to Stay Briefing Schedule and Decision on the Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment²* (“Rule of Law Motion”) and any response by defendant City and Borough of Juneau (“CBJ”) to the *Motion for Summary Judgment³*

(“Summary Judgment Motion”) may be filed after the court’s decision on CBJ’s *Motion for Stay*.⁴
