[Proposed] Order Granting Plaintiffs' Motion to Take Judicial Notice

Plaintiffs Cruise Lines International Association Alaska and Cruise Lines International Association ("CLIA" or "Plaintiffs"), by and through their respective counsel, filed a Motion to Take Judicial Notice in Connection with CLIA's Opposition to City and Borough of Juneau's Motion to Determine the Law of the Case on the Tonnage Clause and Rivers and Harbors Act requesting the Undersigned to take judicial notice of two exhibits attached to CLIA's Opposition.

Upon review, the Motion is **GRANTED**. Exhibits 1 and 2 are properly subject to judicial notice by this Court. Exhibit 1 contains information on the City and Borough of Juneau's processes for accepting project proposals from the public for future expenditures of Marine Passenger Fee proceeds. City and Borough of Juneau is a government entity and has made the information available to the public on its government website. Exhibit 2 contains all actions taken on Senate Bill 1214, the Maritime Transportation Security Act of 2002. Additionally, both Exhibits are available via the worldwide web and the Court has been supplied with the necessary information to access the websites and confirm the accuracy of the documents' content. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Evidence 201 and consistent with Local Rule 7.1(d), the Court hereby takes judicial notice of each of the exhibits listed herein.
