Summary:

On 07-28-2007, at 6:43am, The Juneau Police Department received a report of a vehicle submerged in the water at Aurora Harbor.

Responding officers found an older model Chevrolet pickup had apparently been pushed from the parking area down a steep embankment and into the water. A small amount of oil and gasoline could be seen leaking from the truck.

The US coast guard responded to assist in hooking up the vehicle to a wrecker so it could be pulled from the water.

Coast Guard personnel estimated the amount of petroleum products that leaked into the harbor to be 5 gallons or less, and no clean-up efforts were necessary. They advised the tide cycles should carry the oil away without any permanent effects.

The investigation into how the truck got into the water and who might be responsible continues.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
