Update:

The 55 year old man was questioned and released.

Officers continue to investigate the incident.

Summary:

On 12/19/2010, at approximately 9:30 PM, the Juneau Police Department received a report that someone was shooting a firearm in Aurora Harbor. The caller said that her boyfriend contacted an individual at the end of N Float, who was carrying a pistol.

Juneau Police Officers arrived and the sporadic shooting was still occurring. While officers were on scene three lamps used to illuminate the main float were shot out. Officer interviewed the original caller, and her boyfriend, and obtained a description of the male who had been holding the pistol.

Officers contact a 55 year old Juneau resident, who matched the description of the person holding the pistol. The male suspect was detained and transported to the Juneau Police Department.

Members of the Juneau Police Department SWAT team arrived and cleared the North end of Aurora Harbor where the incident is believed to have occurred. For approximately 64 minutes the electrical power to the downtown area was cut off until the North end of Aurora Harbor could be isolated.

The investigation continues.

All factual allegations contained in this release are based upon preliminary investigation and are subject to change or clarification as the investigation continues. Any charges reported in this release are merely accusations and all persons named in this release are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
