Summary: On 04-18-08 at about 0807 hours, the Juneau Police Department and Alaska State Troopers responded to a residence on Tongass Blvd near Glacier Valley School for a report of a family disturbance. The caller, who was not at the residence, said her 20 year old son was fighting with a family member. There was reported to be a rifle inside the residence but the rifle was not used to threaten anyone.

On arrival, officers contacted the family member outside who reported the 20 year old male was still inside with the gun. As a precaution, Tongass Blvd was shut down to vehicular traffic and Glacier Valley School was advised to keep the occupants inside until the situation could be stabilized.

A short time later, the 20 year old male exited the residence upon officer request without resistance. Interviews conducted at the scene determined that no crime had occurred. This case was closed.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
