Subject: Criminal Trespass/ Burglary

Summary:

On 06-02-2008 at 1:44pm the Juneau Police Department received a report of three persons trespassing inside a valley residence. The owner of the property called police after he brought a prospective renter to view the house and found the three inside.

Responding officers found two juvenile males age 14 and 16 and one adult male age 20 in a rear bedroom. The 16 year old Juneau resident was extremely intoxicated. The other two had not been drinking.

Officers also found in the house numerous items that had been reported stolen in residential burglaries in the valley over the past two days. The items ranged from a TV set, video game console, household goods, cash, jewelry, alcoholic beverages and even the remains of a day old pizza.

All three were taken into custody charged with Criminal Trespass in the 1st degree. The 16 year old was taken to Bartlett Regional Hospital due to his level of intoxication and subsequently lodged at the Johnson Youth Center. The 14 year old Juneau resident had an outstanding Juvenile Detention Order and was additionally charged with Criminal Trespass in 1st. The adult, 20 year old Roy Williams was arrested for Criminal Trespass 1st and lodged at the state prison in lieu of \$1500 cash bail.

The investigation into the trio's involvement in the string of residential burglaries continues with additional charges expected.
