Summary:

On June 3, 2008 at approximately 3:20 am, a caller who resides in the 500 block of 3rd Street Juneau phoned the Juneau Police Department to report a male had illegally entered the artic entryway of his residence. The caller said he observed the male go through some of his personal property, which the male then attempted to steal. The caller said the male was then seen to exit the arctic entry way, walk around to the back of his residence, and try to enter through a back door. The caller confronted the subject at the door and the subject ran. The caller provided police with a description of the male.

At approximately 3:30 am, Officers located 30-year-old Juneau resident, Chadwell CLEVENGER near the 500 block of 3rd Street. CLEVENGER matched the description provided by the caller. CLEVENGER was also positively identified by the caller as the same male who had entered the 3rd Street residence. CLEVENGER was found to have assorted property on his person that was later determined to have been allegedly stolen from a second home in the 500 block of 3rd Street, Juneau.

CLEVENGER was arrested and charged with Attempted Burglary 1st Degree, a Class C Felony, and Burglary in the 1st Degree, a class B Felony. CLEVENGER was lodged at the Lemon Creek Correctional Center under no bail.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
