Summary:
On 09-22-2008 at 5:18pm the Juneau Police Department received a report that a light blue pickup had struck a vehicle parked in front of a valley residence and then fled the scene.

As the hit and run vehicle continued, it struck an occupied vehicle causing minor injury to a 37 year old Juneau man. The hit and run vehicle fled that scene and continued until it crashed in a valley residential neighborhood and was disabled by damage. Witnesses detained the driver until police arrived.

The man fought with arresting officers and gave them a false name. He was subsequently identified as 38 year old Juneau resident Patrick Jaynes. Investigation revealed Jaynes to have an outstanding no bail parole warrant.

In addition to the warrant, Jaynes was lodged at Lemon Creek Correctional Center on numerous other Misdemeanor and Felony charges arising out of this incident. Those charges include DUI "C" felony, Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test "C" felony, Assault in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ degree " $C$ " felony, and Duty of Operator a " $B$ " felony. Misdemeanor charges include Resisting Arrest, False Information, and Driving Without a License.
