Summary:

On October 11, 2008 at about 438 PM, the Juneau Police Department received a report of an assault from a 29 year old female Juneau resident, that occurred in an apartment building on Franklin Street. The female reported that about an hour earlier while she was inside her apartment, she heard noise at her door and then her door was kicked open breaking the door and a man entered the apartment. The man then assaulted her by pointing a gun at her demanding money and stuff belonging to him. The woman said she did not have any items belonging to the man but gave him money. The man then left the apartment.

The woman provided Juneau Police Officers with a description of the suspect and a possible identification of the suspect was made. Officers attempted to locate the suspect in the downtown area. Investigation continues.

*****UPDATE****

On October 12, 2008 at approximately 630 PM, Dirk DAUGHERTY, a 27 year old Juneau Resident, telephoned the Juneau Police Department to talk to officers about the robbery. DAUGHERTY had previously been positively identified by the 29 year old victim and was being sought in connection to this report.

Officers made contact with DAUGHERTY in the 2000 block of Meadow Lane. DAUGHERTY was taken into custody without incident. DAUGHERTY was charged with Robbery in the First Degree a Class A Felony, Burglary 1st Degree a Class B Felony, and Assault in the Third Degree a Class C Felony. DAUGHERTY was lodged at the Lemon Creek Correctional Center without bail.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
