Summary: On 11-19-08 at about 0300 hours, the Juneau Police Dept. responded to Mendenhall River Community School for a burglary alarm. On arrival, it was determined that entry had been gained to the back of the building through an exterior classroom door. It had been forced open.

As officers were arriving on scene, a subject was contacted at the door and fled back into the school where he exited out another door at the back of the school. He was not located. When the subject ran, he lost both of his shoes which were taken for evidence.

Further investigation revealed there were likely two parties involved and they caused about \$1,000 damage to the school and had attempted to steal about \$100 in property.
