Summary:

On Sunday morning Feb. 22nd at 2:56am, the mother of a 22 year old Juneau woman called the Juneau Police Department to report someone had broken into her daughters residence and had beaten her.

Investigation revealed 23 year old Natasha James entered the victim's residence and assaulted her, then returned a 2nd time, broke down the door, and assaulted her again. The victim was taken to Bartlett Regional Hospital for treatment of her injuries.

James was lodged at Lemon Creek Correctional Center on charges of Burglary in the 1st Degree and Assault in the 4th Degree. She was held without bail.
