Summary:

On 03-13-09 about 2002 hours, JPD received a phone call from a female Juneau resident stating her 15-year-old son was grabbed by the neck by a 30-year-old male who demanded money from him. The suspect fled in a silver colored mini van toward Glacier Highway.

On arrival, officers contacted the victim who said he was walking from the Nugget Mall toward the Kootznoowoo building. When a male grabbed him by the neck forced him to empty his pockets, took the money he had, and fled in a silver colored mini van.

The suspect could not be immediately located in the area.

The suspect is described as a dark skin male, about 5'9", 200 pounds about in his late 20's early 30's. He was last seen wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, grey sweat pant and a baseball cap on backwards. He also had the hood of his sweatshirt over the hat.

Investigation into this incident is ongoing and if anyone has information they are encouraged to contact the Juneau Police Dept. at 586-0600.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
