Subject: Car Riflings

Summary:

On 12/04/2010 at about 8:43 am, the Juneau Police Department (JPD) received a report from a resident on Hamilton St that someone had rifled through his unlocked vehicle during the night and stolen his wallet.

On 12/04/10 at about 9:22 am, JPD received a report from a resident on Wildmeadow Ln that someone had rifled through three of his unlocked vehicles during the night. The resident reported that nothing was stolen from the vehicles.

JPD officers responded to the area and found that a total of six vehicles on Wildmeadow Ln, four vehicles on Hamilton St, and four vehicles on Frank Meier Dr had been rifled through. The owners of the vehicles were contacted and a list of stolen property was recorded by officers. All vehicles were unlocked at the time of the incident.

An investigation continues into the incident as officers were unable to locate a suspect in the area.

This incident is thought to have occurred on Glacier Highway, from the area between Brotherhood Bridge and Auke Lake. If residents along this area discover that their parked vehicles have been entered and items stolen, they are encouraged to call JPD at 586-0600. Residents are also encouraged to always lock their vehicles while they are unattended.

All factual allegations contained in this release are based upon preliminary investigation and are subject to change or clarification as the investigation continues. Any charges reported in this release are merely accusations and all persons named in this release are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
